Transferring Registration from a Previous CinemaCon

If you have an authorized transfer of CinemaCon registration fees from a previous show, please contact the <u>Registration</u> <u>Center</u> **before you register** for verification and registration assistance.

Package Descriptions

International Package – Geared specifically to those industry professionals in the International Market—Includes *ALL* scheduled and sponsored CinemaCon events and functions included in the Domestic Package *PLUS* all programming and sponsored events associated with International Day on Monday, 25 April. (Programming begins at approximately 8:00am and runs through Thursday evening, 28 April). For those interested in INTERNATIONAL markets, this is your Best Value!

Domestic Package – Includes all scheduled and sponsored CinemaCon Events—studio presentations and screenings, seminars, trade show, food functions and of course, the Final Night Awards Ceremony and Dinner. Official CinemaCon Programming is scheduled to begin at approximately 1:30pm on Monday, 25 April and runs through Thursday evening, 28 April. This is your Best Value!

Trade Show and Seminar Package – Gains admittance to officially scheduled CinemaCon seminars and the Trade Show. Screenings and sponsored food events are NOT included.

Trade Show Pass / Trade Show Exhibitor / Guest – Permits access to the CinemaCon Trade Show ONLY. Screenings, sponsored events and seminars are NOT included.

Group Registration

Online Registration and Payment

On-line registration closes 12:00 noon PST on Wednesday, 20 April 2022. Payment must be submitted with registration via credit card (Visa, MasterCard or American Express). All financial transactions will be processed in U.S. dollars at the current rate of exchange.

Paying by Check or Wire Transfer

To pay by check or wire transfer, submit the attached registration form with the actual check or confirmation of wire transfer by Friday, 15 April 2022. Checks must be in US Dollars, drawn on a US bank and should be made payable to CinemaCon LLC. Instructions for wire transfer payments to CinemaCon can be obtained from Cynthia Schuler at Cynthia.Schuler@natodc.com. **Registrants must pay all bank fees**. Forms received without payment will NOT be processed.

Registrations not paid in full by 15 April 2022 may be canceled. Those affected will be required to register on site at the prevailing registration rates.

Confirmation

Registration confirmation will arrive via email shortly after submitting an online registration. If you mail or fax your registration, the confirmation will arrive once the form is received and processed. If you do not receive a confirmation email in a timely manner, please notify the Registration Center at cinemacon2022@anidealpartner.com.

Covid-19 Safety Protocols

In looking out for the health, safety and welfare of all attendees, everyone picking up a registration or badge (staff, delegate, trade show guest, exhibitor trade show booth personnel) must present one of two options for entry to CinemaCon 2022:

- Proof of full COVID-19 vaccination (digital copy of vaccination record will be accepted)
- OR a negative antigen/PCR COVID-19 test conducted within 48-hours of picking up credentials
- PLUS an appropriate photo ID matching the name on the required documentation.

Mask mandates will follow CDC/Clark County guidelines and will be published at https://cinemacon.com/covid-safety-protocols. **No exceptions will be made** to these health and safety protocols.

While we may have an official Covid Testing Facility on site, our recommendation is to arrive at registration with your required documentation in hand. Everyone will be given a wristband that must be shown when entering officially scheduled events at the show.

Badges and Required Identification

You will be required to show a current, valid government picture ID (driver's license, passport, etc), plus proof of full Covid-19 vaccination or proof of a negative Covid-19 test to receive your CinemaCon badge and other materials. Be sure to check the schedule at www.cinemacon.com for registration hours and locations. Your badge and wristband should be worn at all times and are required for admission to all events.

Substitution and Changes

Substitutions are allowed with the permission of the original registrant. A substitution is a straight transfer of registration credentials with no adjustment to the registration category or payment. If a change to the registration category or payment is required, the original registrant will be canceled with a \$100 administrative fee and the new registrant will be processed at the prevailing rate.

Refunds and Cancellations

Registrants who are unable to attend may substitute another person. In the event no substitution can be made, CinemaCon will process a refund minus a \$100 processing fee through 31 March. Cancellations received after 31 March, as well as unused registrations or tickets, will not be refunded. CinemaCon will not be responsible for any variances in exchange rates between the original charge and refund.

In the event CinemaCon 2022 cannot take place, all paid registrants will be given the option of a full refund or a transfer to the next scheduled CinemaCon.
